# MINUTES VILLAGE OF CRETE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES MEETING August 27, 2018

# **REGULAR BOARD MEETING:**

President Michael Einhorn called the regular board meeting of the President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Crete to order on Monday, August 27, 2018 at 7:00 pm in the municipal building at 524 W. Exchange Street, Crete, Illinois. President Einhorn led those assembled in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

On a roll call by Village Clerk Deborah Bachert the following were present: Trustees Holly Milburn, Doris Harmon-Warren, Stephen Johnson and Mark Wiater and President Michael Einhorn. Trustees Steve Beaudoin and Ray Harley were absent. A quorum was present.

Also in attendance: Attorney James Stevenson, Administrator Michael Smith, Supt. #### CITIZENS' SPEAK

Visitors are always welcome to all public meetings of the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Crete. Interested parties wishing to speak should identify their intent to speak, they then may give their name and where they reside if they so choose and then make their comment. Persons may also provide their address privately to the Village Clerk if they so choose; persons are advised that addresses are considered private information under the Freedom of Information Act and thus are exempt from disclosure pursuant to any Freedom of Information Act request. However, in order to give proper consideration to all items on the agenda, the President has the authority to limit participants in debates and will close repetitive or abusive remarks. In addition, public comment rules are posted in the board room.

# 1. Fire Department Promotions:

Fire Chief Waterman introduced the members for promotion as listed above. Clerk Bachert administered the Fireman's Pledge to them. Congratulations to these members of the fire department for their dedication to serve the Village of Crete and surrounding communities.

#### **CITIZENS' SPEAK continued:**

Trustee Steve Beaudoin arrived at 7:08 pm.

2. Presentation by Crete-Monee School District Superintendent Dr. Kara Coglianese and Assistant Superintendent of Business Ken Surma concerning the proposed building program.

Interim School Superintendent Dr. Kara Coglianese and Assistant Superintendent Ken Surma made a presentation to the Village Board and the audience concerning the new plan to restructure the school system. The restructuring will include a new approach to teaching as well as a new set of goals for the District. "Future Ready" is the new vision for making a unified district for students to become prepared for their future. The intent is to, over time, close all the current older elementary buildings and build a new Pre K to 2<sup>nd</sup> grade building at the location of the old high school, which is scheduled to be torn down by the end of November. Proposed additions are also planned to be made to the existing Monee Elementary School Building which will become a grade 3 to 5 center. 10 class rooms will be added to the Middle School which will house grades 6 to 8. The total cost of the plan will be around \$84M which will be borrowed in four amounts over time and paid off over a 20 year period without the need to increase the tax rate. Two upcoming meetings will be held for discussion on these plans with Dr. Coglianese. The dates are Thursday, September 6, 2018 at Crete-Monee High School from 5:30 – 7:00 pm and Monday, September 10, 2018 at Coretta Scott King Magnet School from 5:30 – 7:00 pm.

3. Dean Gaffney expressed his concerns for quality of life within the Village due to the number of gambling establishments located in the downtown Crete area. It was explained to him that limitations are in place.

# **OLD BUSINESS:**

1. Ordinance 2018- : An Ordinance authorizing the Village of Crete to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Crete-Monee Community Unit School District 201-U for the placement of School Resource Officers in school buildings. The agreement has been discussed at previous board meetings over the past year. Board action is anticipated.

This matter was delayed once again as it was missing some financial information that has yet to be agreed upon. This agreement will probably not actually take effect until sometime in February 2019 and will be placed on the agenda when ready.

2. EMA building project. The EMA building project has been discussed at many prior meetings. The design drawings and engineering drawings have been completed. The next step is to proceed to preparation of a construction contract and selection of a general contractor. The Board is being requested for direction. The final contract version will be presented to the Board for approval by way of resolution for passage. Board action may be taken.

The Board verbally instructed the Village Attorney to complete the owner-constructor written agreement needed to proceed with the construction of the new EMA building that will be located at 280 W Exchange.
